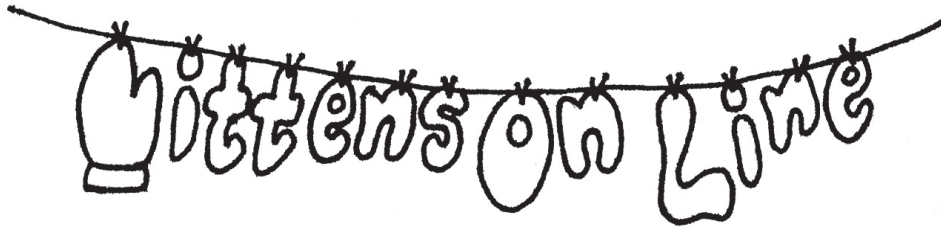


Block Exchange Pattern



Let yourself have fun with this!

Cut a 9" square blue (sky) background fabric. (This will be trimmed to 8 1/2" before you hand it in.)

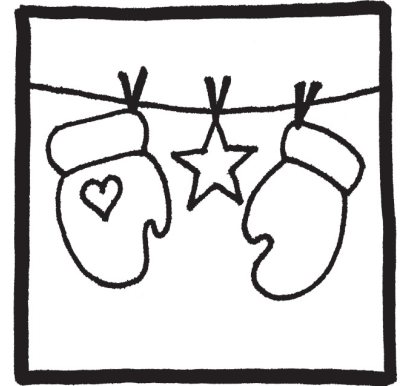
For the clothesline, you might use string, hand stitch it, freehand machine stitch it, use ribbon, or whatever. Start and end your clothesline 2" down from the top of your 9" square.

Trace mitten, heart & star patterns in any quantity you like and applique them to the square so that they look as if they are hanging on the clothesline. (Leave about 3/4" on either side for trimming & seam allowance when positioning your clothesline items.)

You might applique by hand or use a lightweight fusible just around the edges & then either hand stitch or machine stitch the edges to finish them. No raw edges, please.

To complete your portrait of winter, you will need some clothespins—either hand or machine stitched. Feel free to embellish as you wish. Trim your completed block to 8 1/2".
