

# WEB EXTRA: TALL BUTTON JAR

This is an additional block that can be used in your mystery sewing room wallhanging--or make several and create a row of button jars to hang in sewing room. This block will equal two of the 6 1/2" blocks in the wallhanging and finish at 6 1/2" x 13".

## Fabric Cutting Guide:

### From the white on white or solid white background, cut:

Two 1 1/2" wide x 13" tall strips for sides  
Four 1 1/2" square for jar lid extensions and jar shoulders  
One 4 1/4" wide x 3 1/2" for above jar top  
Two 1" square for bottom of jar corners  
One 1" x 7" strip for bottom of block

### From jar lid fabric, cut:

One 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" strip

### From "Glass" fabric or pre-printed button fabric, cut:

One 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle

Sew two of the 1 1/2" background squares to the corners of the top of the jar rectangle diagonally to create the jar shoulders. Sew the 1" white squares to the bottom jar corners diagonally to create the rounded jar base. Stitch a 1 1/2" background square to each side of the jar lid fabric. Add the white 4 1/4" x 3 1/2" strip to the top of this unit, then sew this unit to the jar rectangle.

Add a white 1 1/2" x 13" strip to each side of the jar unit, then add the bottom 1" x 7" white strip to the bottom. Trim the bottom strip to 1/2" deep, then trim block to 6 1/2" x 12 1/2". Sew on as many buttons as desired; the more the merrier.

This block is not suitable for the block exchange, but will add some texture and dimension to your wallhanging.
